IFIP WG 2.6 Membership Rules

Approved on 4 Oct, 2023

IFIP WG 2.6 has three following types of membership: an observer, a regular member, and an emeritus member. Inclusion into a given membership type is guided by the rules stated below.

An observer

- 1. can be suggested by any WG 2.6 member
- 2. is invited by the WG 2.6 chair
- 3. can actively participate in any WG 2.6 initiative
- 4. can propose and lead a WG 2.6 initiative
- 5. attends all WG 2.6 meetings
- 6. has no voting rights
- 7. can be approved as a member during an annual WG 2.6 meeting, having served as an observer at least for 1 year; the process of an approval can be initiated by any member
- 8. can be approved as a regular member by a majority voting of those members that participate in an annual WG 2.6 meeting
- 9. a list of observers approved by WG2.6 needs further be approved by TC2 members during their annual meeting

A regular member

- 1. has full voting rights
- 2. a member that has not participated in any group activity for 3 consecutive years, is asked by the group chair whether he/she is interested in working within the group
- 3. an inactive regular member can:
 - become an emeritus member by expressing his/her will in an email to the WG 2.6 chair
 - give up his/her WG 2.6 membership by expressing his/her will in an email to the WG 2.6 chair
- 4. in any point of time, a member can step down from the group by informing the WG 2.6 chair by email

An emeritus member

- 1. does not have voting rights
- 2. receives all WG 2.6 email communication
- 3. may attend WG 2.6 meetings and other group events
- 4. may regain the regular member status at any time, by expressing his/her will in an email to the WG 2.6 chair
