Grading policy

During the course of the semester, on each meeting students will get an exercise concerning the subject discussed on a given meeting. Completing all of these exercises results in a grade 3.0. Each exercise should be personally presented by the next meeting. Each student is entitled to skipping 2 weeks worth of assignments. Skipping more than two results in student's grade being taken down by half a mark (in case of some exercises by more, which will be clearly signaled on a given class). During the semester there will also be additional assignments. Completing each of these assignments upgrades the student's final result by half a mark.

Around the middle of the semester, the final project will be announced. By completing the project students can upgrade their final score by two grades.

Solutions to all exercises, assignments, and projects have to be prepared personally. An attempt at plagiarism regarding any of these solutions will result in failing the student immediately (grade 2.0 in the first attempt).

Each student's presence during the classes is compulsory. Each student is entitled to 2 unexcused absences. Each unexcused absence on top of these two results in downgrading the final score by half a mark. A student's absence on more than half of the meetings results in him/her failing the course.

Students should collect all of the solutions prepared during the semester and send them to the tutor by the end of the semester in a single zip file entitled with a given student's last name and the first letter of the first name, e.g., for student John Smith, the file should be entitled SmithJ.zip.
