## Main features

- It's a library
- Emphasis on separating view layers
- CSS selectors
- Many extensions available
- Popular
- Easier use of AJAX and JSON

### AJAX

- Asynchronous JavaScript and XML
- Asynchronous
  - The calls are... asynchronous...
- ...JavaScript
  - **—** ...
- ...and XML
  - Doesn't have to be XML JSON, HTML, text, etc.
- Based on XMLHttpRequest

## **JSON**

- JavaScript Object Notation
- Light format
- How it compares to XML?
  - Capable of expressing the same data
  - No schema validation
  - Easier to parse than XML
- Many popular services share their data using JSON
  - Blogs, news services, facebook, flickr, ...
